**Consultation time with Bonnie Kellerby-2 hours**  
**Initial Contact to final consultation: 1 week**

Initially, Bonnie presented slightly nervous and formal, as is expected under evaluation. In an effort to try to explain what had happened to her she became tangential due to the complicated nature of the story. She wanted me to understand what she was experiencing and so negated my questions in favor of telling her story. This is a normal course of events for targeted individuals because up until the time that they talk to me they usually haven't been able to openly confide in many people and so stories often come out in a flood. I allowed Bonnie to tell her story with few interruptions. As expected, she was able to relax after opening up.

Bonnie spoke of her belief about the possibility of having been micro-chipped because of the electronic-type frequencies that she can hear and feel. As a targeted individual, she has never experienced the more common assaults that are normally reported by T.I.'s such as, stalking, vandalization, noise harassment, break-ins, gassing, etc. Bonnie reports that she doesn't know who is responsible for the micro-chipping or why it was done and goes on to say that her husband believes that this is happening, as well, and fully supports her.

Bonnie has been to a doctor regarding the audible frequencies and she reports that the doctors have stated that she may be experiencing a heightened, neurological sensitivity and receptivity due to an over-active thyroid. Bonnie is planning to have a physical which will address this possibility.

Generally, Bonnie did not present as guarded, suspicious, or paranoid. Bonnie is well-organized and is a full-time home-maker and house-keeper, as is her preference. She did not display any psychotic behaviors in any way and is in process of medically investigating the possibility of being micro-chipped.

I believe Bonnie Kellerby to have been of generally sound mind at the time of our consultations.
