



Ladies and gentlemen of the press:

This press release is in response to a June 26, 2018 news story as reported by ABC13 and other news outlets claiming a police officer in Houston was harmed by touching one of our pdf downloadable flyers that was placed on her windshield by an unknown person. The story claimed that the flyer was contaminated with the drug fentanyl, which had purportedly been absorbed through the officer's skin.

The following is Targeted Justice's full response:

Target Justice is a 501(c3) non-profit Human Rights Organization that is committed to promoting public awareness and legal action for citizens who are being subjected to government sponsored human rights abuses.

Target Justice is dedicated to conducting all of its activities with civility, integrity and according to non-violent principals, as stated on our website. Our board, executive team, and members are victims of a staggering range of human rights violations, and as such, we do not endorse any activity that would endanger or harm another human. In fact, we stand staunchly against cruelty, violence and injustice wherever it comes from, even and especially from a perversion of authority.

We stand for the US Constitution and the American values of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness, and the importance of the inalienable rights of the individual.

We thus far have a membership of close to 500 and our membership expands daily. Our website, which is publicly viewable, currently has approximately 30,000 viewers per month, attesting to the relevance of the information on it. We often upload pdf files to our website containing pertinent information for all concerned citizens that can be downloaded, printed and used as flyers by any person who wishes to do so.

We were relieved to receive the information this morning, via *USA Today*, that a spokesman for the Harris County Sheriff's office confirmed that the Houston sergeant's positive fentanyl test did not come from the flyer placed on her vehicle, and that she is in good health. Apparently flyers are being tested, and we await the outcome of those tests.

Some media outlets are reporting that Targeted Justice is an antigovernment organization. This is an incorrect conclusion, and no spokesperson for our organization was consulted regarding our purpose or activities. The information on our website and flyers is heavily researched, and can be backed up with solid evidence. Please contact us for such information.

One of our Executive Team members, Karen Stewart, spent her career as an Intelligence Analyst with the National Security Agency. Another, Midge Mathis, worked for two different governors for the Board of Behavioral Health for the State of Arizona. Other team members are spread all over the country and are a combination of one Federal worker, a retired NASA engineer, a legal student on his second career, and other highly educated professionals.
