McCarthy Blacklist

Targeted Justice filed a lawsuit seeking to have the court declare unconstitutional, a "McCarthy Blacklist" hidden within the FBI's Terrorist Screening Database (TSDB). More than 6 million civilians worldwide, are being subjected to stalking, harassment, slander, threats, assault, and torture. The FBI uses the terms "Targets" or "Non-Investigative Subjects" (NIS), to identify these innocent people. In the U.S. alone, there are more than 300,000 innocent civilians on this blacklist. We are Targeted Individuals.

The database is distributed thru the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) where targets are listed under "Handling Code 3 or 4," because they do not represent a National Security threat, yet Police routinely refer to them as "suspected terrorists."

No List = No Targets

- 1. In 2003, President Bush signed HSPD-6, authorizing the listing of "known or appropriately suspected" terrorists' names. No other names are allowed on the list.
- 2. According to FBI Agents under oath: 97% of the TSDB names have no known ties to terrorism.
- 3. Less than 0.5% of the TSDB consists of "Known or Suspected Terrorists."
- 4. There is no meaningful redress procedure for someone named as a "suspected terrorist" and "non-investigative subject." Violation of the 4th, 5th, and 6th Amendments.
- 5. The FBI & DOJ continue to deceive and hide the actual numbers placed on this secret blacklist.
- 6. Why are minor children, some just 3-years old, listed as "suspected terrorists" on the TSDB?
